Hydrometry & Telemetry Officer?

The work of our Hydrometry & Telemetry Officers is essential in our ability to manage Water Resources. They collect, measure, record and monitor river flow, lakes, rainfall and groundwater level data, as well as managing data telemetry systems (which are remote, wireless sensors that provide essential data).

What does the day-to-day look like?

- Ensuring the hydrometric monitoring network performs at its peak
- Providing additional data and information when required, e.g. during droughts
- Carrying out regular site visits to ensure data is collected accurately
- Calibrating and fixing equipment on-site
- Using remote control boats, cameras and survey equipment for additional data collection



What skills do you need?

- Flexibility and adaptability to respond to challenges
- Ability to organise workload and meet deadlines
- Data literacy - the ability to manage, interpret and present a large amount of data effectively
- An analytical and problem-solving approach
- An interest in the environment and a mixture of working outdoors and in an office
